Steamboat, Arizona – In the past three years, Supervisor Alton Joe Shepherd has worked toward the goal of "**Better Roads and Better Communities**" through **Purpose, Planning, Partnership and Progress**. Supervisor Shepherd is achieving these goals and is working toward long term solutions for our county roads. Building on our successes, the Supervisor is committed to strengthening and expanding our outreach and initiatives within Apache County District 2.

With these continued goals, Supervisor Shepherd is proud to announce that the STEP-UP road project C-429 South (Balakai Road) has completed Phase 2 of its improvements. This work comprised of 1 mile of limestone overlay on C-429 South from Junction C-416 toward Junction C-286. This project consisted of culvert cleaning, sub-grade preparation and limestone placement. Phase 3 will be conducted once the weather improves to above 50 degrees and climbing along with ground temperatures. Thereafter, District 2 will process Durablend, a soil stabilizer on the road to assist in the longevity of these improvements. Supervisor Shepherd thanks the community for their patience and cooperation as these improvements are made.

Supervisor Shepherd also expresses his gratitude to the dedicated and hard-working staff and crew of District 2. They have managed to adjust to the ever changing terrain and create an atmosphere for success. With their support and work, we are able to continue operations and help our elders and children during this time.
